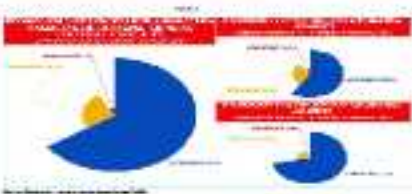

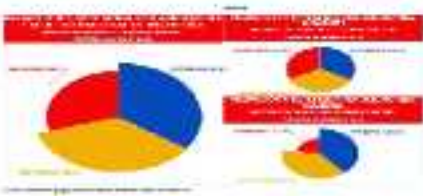

Abstract

The purpose of this study was to determine the effect of a 6-week training program on the physical fitness and health-related quality of life (HRQL) of sedentary middle-aged women. The subjects were randomly assigned to either a control group or an exercise group. The exercise group performed a supervised aerobic and resistance training program three times per week. The control group did not participate in any structured exercise program. Physical fitness measures included maximal oxygen consumption ($\dot{V}O_{2\max}$), peak power output (PPO), and body composition. HRQL was measured using the SF-36 questionnaire. The results showed that the exercise group had significantly higher values for $\dot{V}O_{2\max}$, PPO, and body composition compared to the control group at the end of the 6-week program. Additionally, the exercise group showed significant improvements in several HRQL domains, including physical functioning, role limitations due to physical problems, bodily pain, general health perception, vitality, and social functioning. These findings suggest that a 6-week supervised exercise program can effectively improve both physical fitness and HRQL in sedentary middle-aged women.
